LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (LAX)  
DEVIATION FROM OVER-OCEAN OPERATIONS  
May 15 - 17, 2017  
12 AM – 6:30 AM

LAX will temporarily deviate from Over-Ocean Operations for three nights (12 AM – 6:30 AM) on Monday, May 15th through Wednesday, May 17th due to the closure of both runways on the south complex. The south inboard runway 25R/7L is currently closed for ongoing Runway Safety Area construction through May 25, 2017. In addition to this ongoing inboard runway closure, the south outboard runway 25L/7R is scheduled to close during these three nights, May 15-17, for routine maintenance.

Whenever possible, the FAA transitions [LAX air traffic flow](#) to Over-Ocean Operations from 12 AM to 6:30 AM, wherein aircraft arrive and depart over the ocean to minimize noise disturbance to the communities directly east of the airport. During this traffic flow, the south runway complex is utilized primarily for departures while the north runway complex is utilized primarily for arrivals.

With both runways closed on the south complex, the FAA will need to deviate temporarily from Over-Ocean Operations, maintain air traffic in Westerly Operations, and direct all aircraft operations to the north runway complex during these three nights. As a result, persons living near the airport may notice a change in aircraft flight activity and associated noise.
