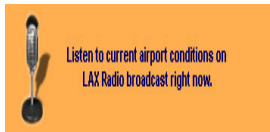


Marvin's Complimentary Shoe Shine

Korean Air will launch new, nonstop service on June 2 from LAX to São Paulo, Brazil. The flight is scheduled to depart LAX at 7:30 p.m. and arrive in São Paulo at 11 a.m. the next day. The return flight will leave São Paulo at 1:30 p.m. and arrive LAX at 9:30 p.m. the same day. Korean Air will be the only airline with nonstop service between Los Angeles and Brazil.
