#### **LAX FlyAway Increases Union Station Service**

The LAX FlyAway bus service serving Union Station will increase the frequency of morning service Mondays through Fridays. Effective July 28, 2008, daily morning departures from Union Station to LAX will depart at 5:00 a.m., 5:30 a.m., 5:50 a.m., 6:30 a.m., 6:45 a.m., 7:10 a.m., 7:30 a.m., 7:50 a.m., 8:10 a.m., 8:30 a.m., 8:50 a.m., 9:10 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and then every 30 minutes on the hour and half hour. #### **Places to Visit During a Flight Layover at LAX**

Depending on the length of the layover, travelers have a variety of options for leisure activities located within a few miles of LAX.

**Santa Monica:** Features outdoor shopping, street performers, restaurants, and a small amusement park on the pier. Although other beaches may be closer to LAX, there is a "rapid" bus that goes quickly to Santa Monica with a minimum number of stops.

**Sony Pictures Studios:** Less than four miles north of LAX, Sony Pictures Studios offers two-hour walking tours on weekdays. Reservations are highly recommended. No children under age 12.

### TSA's 3-1-1 For Carry-Ons

3-1-1= 3 ounce bottle or less (by volume); 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag and 1 bag per passenger placed in the screening bin. The one-quart bag per person limits the total liquid volume each traveler can bring on board with them, and the 3 oz. container size is a security measure. 3-1-1 is best used for short trips; if in doubt, put liquids in checked luggage. ### Delta Air Lines Has Made More Cuts in Service at LAX

Delta Air Lines discontinued its nonstop service between 13 cities and LAX, including flights to Seattle, Portland and Phoenix. The flights were halted by ExpressJet, operating under a contract with Delta Air Lines. Service will officially end Sept. 1, due to high fuel costs and declining demand.
